Priest On the night he was betrayed,

Priest At the end of the supper, taking the cup of wine,

Priest As we proclaim his death and celebrate his
rising in glory,
send your Holy Spirit that this bread and this wine
may be to us the body and blood of your dear Son.

make us one in Christ, our risen Lord.**

Priest With your whole Church throughout the world
we offer you this sacrifice of praise
and lift our voice to join the eternal song of heaven;

All **Holy, holy, holy Lord.
God of power and might,
heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.**

Priest As our Saviour taught us, so we pray,
All **Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name,
your kingdom come, your will be done,

Forgive us our sins,
as we forgive those who sin against us.
Lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil.
